- Target Group:** Seafarers employed or engaged in any capacity on board ship.
- Objective:** The objective of familiarization training is to ensure that seafarers who are going to work on a ship for the first time, know basic personal safety information that may save their lives and fellow crew members in the event of an emergency
- Introduction:** This learning opportunity is designed for the training of seafarers in any capacity wishing to pursue a career at sea. This learning opportunity is designed in such a way as to achieve the Survival at Sea competencies as described in the STCW and SAMSA Codes respectively.
